## Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In January 2023, The Carrboro Police Department recorded 1,292 calls for service as compared to 1,401 in the same month the previous year (2022).

Traffic Stops: In January 2023, Carrboro Police performed 119 traffic stops. As a result of those stops 53 citations were issued, 30 verbal warnings given, 24 written warnings issued, 8 on-view arrests were made and 4 instances where no action was taken.

Citations: In January 2023, Carrboro Police issued 62 citations. 22 were regulatory traffic citations, 5 were safety/moving violations, 30 were for speeding, 2 for second degree trespassing, and 1 each for DWI, unlawful possession/use of blue light in motor vehicle, NC Id card fraud.

Arrests: In January 2023, the Carrboro Police Department made 26 on-view/custodial arrests. The arrests range from Failure to appear, defrauding an innkeeper, DWI, PWIMSD marijuana, simple assault, assault on a female, 2<sup>nd</sup> degree trespassing, to misdemeanor child abuse, larceny and possession of stolen goods.

Incident Reports: There were 219 incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of January 2023, as compared to 167 in the same month from last year (2022).


Crashes: There were traffic 36 crashes in the month of January, which included zero fatalities.
