Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In February 2023, The Carrboro Police Department recorded 1,178 calls for service as compared to 1,187 in the same month the previous year (2022).

Traffic Stops: In February 2023, Carrboro Police performed 86 traffic stops. As a result of those stops 35 citations were issued, 22 verbal warnings given, 17 written warnings issued, 10 on-view arrests were made and 2 instances where no action was taken.

Citations: In February 2023, Carrboro Police issued 44 citations. 17 were for speeding, 6 were for unsafe movements, 15 were regulatory, 2 each for concealed carry violation and simple assault, and 1 each for 2nd degree trespassing and alcohol violation.

Arrests: In February 2023, the Carrboro Police Department made 32 on-view/custodial arrests. The arrests range from failure to appear, fraud/obtaining property by false pretense, intoxicated and disruptive, DWI, drive after consuming alcohol < 21, felony possession of cocaine, paraphernalia possession, to DV protection order violation, assault and battery, assault on a female, 2nd degree trespassing, concealed carry violation, possession of firearm by felon, injury to personal property, felony hit and run, misdemeanor larceny, speeding to elude arrest, failing to stop for lights and sirens, and statutory sex offense with a child <= 15.

Incident Reports: There were 212 incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of February 2023, as compared to 202 in the same month from last year (2022).

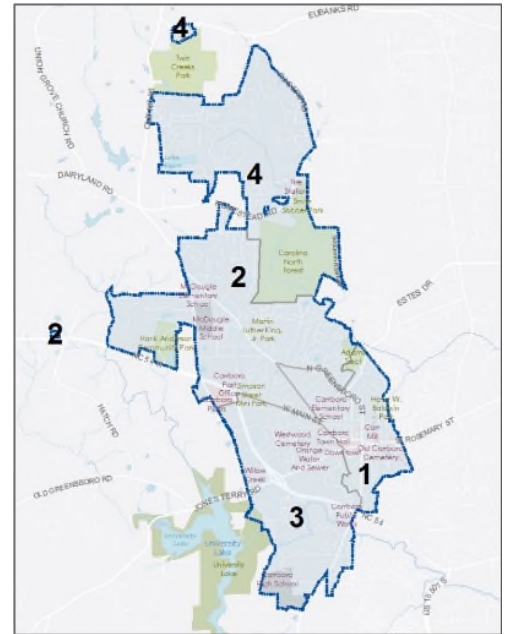
Crashes: There were traffic 36 crashes in the month of February, which included zero fatalities.
