Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In March 2023, The Carrboro Police Department recorded 1,262 calls for service as compared to 1,316 in the same month the previous year (2022).

Traffic Stops: In March 2023, Carrboro Police performed 107 traffic stops. As a result of those stops 36 citations were issued, 33 verbal warnings given, 27 written warnings issued, 9 on-view arrests were made and 2 instances where no action was taken.

Citations: In March 2023, Carrboro Police issued 42 citations. 14 were for speeding, 1 each for unsafe movement, reckless driving/wanton disregard, stop sign violation, and fail to stop for stopped bus, 2 each for pedestrian crossing violation, and unsafe passing, 17 were regulatory, and 3 for 2nd degree trespass.

Arrests: In March 2023, the Carrboro Police Department made 26 on-view/custodial arrests. The arrests range from Assault Inflict serious Injury, Assault of Govt. Official, AWDW ISI, Burglary, Conspiracy, Felony Flee to Elude w/ aggravating factors, Fail to appear in court, Felony probation violation, DWI, Intoxicated and disruptive, misdemeanor larceny and 2nd degree trespassing.

Incident Reports: There were 224 incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of March 2023, as compared to 236 in the same month from last year (2022).


Crashes: There were traffic 25 crashes in the month of March, which included zero fatalities.
