## Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In April 2023, The Carrboro Police Department recorded 1,399 calls for service as compared to 1,385 in the same month the previous year (2022).

Traffic Stops: In April 2023, Carrboro Police performed 109 traffic stops. As a result of those stops 34 citations were issued, 36 verbal warnings given, 24 written warnings issued, 12 on-view arrests were made and 3 instances where no action was taken.

Citations: In April 2023, Carrboro Police issued 47 citations. 13 were for speeding, 25 were regulatory violations, 5 for safety/moving violations, 1 each for shoplifting and possessing paraphernalia, and 2 for 2<sup>nd</sup> degree trespassing.

Arrests: In April 2023, the Carrboro Police Department made 31 on-view/custodial arrests. The arrests range from Simple Assault, Assault on a female, AWDW, Assault Inflict Serious Injury, Burglary 1<sup>st</sup> degree, Common Law Robbery, Communicating Threats, Felony Possession SCH II CS, Fail to appear in court, Death By Distribution, DWI, Intoxicated and Disruptive, Unauthorized Use of Motor Vehicle, Misdemeanor Larceny and 2<sup>nd</sup> degree trespassing.

Incident Reports: There were 215 incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of April 2023, as compared to 222 in the same month from last year (2022).


Crashes: There were traffic 38 crashes in the month of April, which included zero fatalities.
