## Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In May 2023, The Carrboro Police Department recorded 1,478 calls for service as compared to 1,480 in the same month the previous year (2022).

**Traffic Stops:** In May 2023, Carrboro Police performed 95 traffic stops. As a result of those stops 35 citations were issued, 32 verbal warnings given, 18 written warnings issued, 8 on-view arrests were made and 2 instances where no action was taken.

**Citations:** In May 2023, Carrboro Police issued 48 citations. 14 were for speeding, 22 were regulatory violations, 6 for safety/moving violations, 1 each for shoplifting and possessing malt beverage, 2 for 2<sup>nd</sup> degree trespassing, and 1 for misdemeanor breaking and entering.

**Arrests:** In May 2023, the Carrboro Police Department made 27 on-view/custodial arrests. The arrests range from Simple Assault, AWDW, Burning Certain Buildings, Common Law Robbery, Communicating Threats, Defrauding an Innkeeper, Drive After Consuming <21, Felony Possession SCH I CS, PWISD SCH VI CS (F) Failure to appear in court, DWI, Unauthorized Use of Motor Vehicle, Misdemeanor Larceny and 2<sup>nd</sup> degree trespassing.

**Incident Reports:** There were 237 incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of May 2023, as compared to 234 in the same month from last year (2022).


**Crashes:** There were traffic 29 crashes in the month of May, which included one fatality.
