Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In July 2023, The Carrboro Police Department recorded 1,473 calls for service as compared to 1,569 in the same month the previous year (2022).

Traffic Stops: In July 2023, Carrboro Police performed 94 traffic stops. As a result of those stops 38 citations were issued, 27 verbal warnings given, 18 written warnings issued, 9 on-view arrests were made and 2 instances where no action was taken.

Citations: In July 2023, Carrboro Police issued 45 citations. 26 were for speeding, 10 were regulatory violations, 2 for safety/moving violations, 5 for 2nd degree trespassing, 1 each for possession of marijuana paraphernalia and resist, delay and obstruct.

Arrests: In July 2023, the Carrboro Police Department made 42 on-view/custodial arrests. The arrests range from Accessory after the Fact, Alter/Steal/Destroy Criminal Evidence, Assault on a Female, AWDW, AWDW Govt. Official, Break or Enter a Vehicle, Breaking and Entering M and F, B&E Terror or Injury, Common Law Robbery, Communicating Threat, DWI, FTA, Fugitive, Indecent Exposure DEF>18 VIC<16, Indecent Exposure, Injury to Personal Property, Larceny of Automobile, Misdemeanor Larceny, PWISMD SCH II CS, Possess or Manufacture Fraudulent ID, Simple Assault, and 2nd degree trespassing.

Incident Reports: There were 240 incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of July 2023, as compared to 234 in the same month from last year (2022).


Crashes: There were traffic 40 crashes in the month of July, no fatalities recorded.
