Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In August 2023, The Carrboro Police Department recorded 1,529 calls for service as compared to 1,463 in the same month the previous year (2022).

Traffic Stops: In August 2023, Carrboro Police performed 95 traffic stops. As a result of those stops 31 citations were issued, 37 verbal warnings given, 18 written warnings issued, 7 on-view arrests were made and 2 instances where no action was taken.

Citations: In August 2023, Carrboro Police issued 47 citations. 16 were for speeding, 17 were regulatory violations, 4 for safety/moving violations, 5 for 2nd degree trespassing, 2 for shoplifting, 1 each for possessing stolen property, resist, delay and obstruct and animal cruelty.

Arrests: In August 2023, the Carrboro Police Department made 40 on-view/custodial arrests. The arrests range from Failure to Appear in Court, DWI, Intoxicated and Disruptive, Misdemeanor Larceny, (F) First Degree Murder, (F) Possession of Marijuana, Probation Violation, PWIMSD SCH II CS, Resist Delay and Obstruct, 2nd Degree Sexual Offense, Simple Assault, and 2nd Degree Trespassing.

Incident Reports: There were 281 incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of August 2023, as compared to 275 in the same month from last year (2022).


Crashes: There were traffic 34 crashes in the month of August, no fatalities recorded.
