### Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In October 2023, The Carrboro Police Department recorded 1,717 calls for service as compared to 1,289 in the same month the previous year (2022).

Traffic Stops: In October 2023, Carrboro Police performed 118 traffic stops. As a result of those stops 49 citations were issued, 30 verbal warnings given, 28 written warnings issued, 8 on-view arrests were made and 4 instances where no action was taken.

Citations: In October 2023, Carrboro Police issued 68 citations. 29 were for speeding, 19 were regulatory violations, 9 for safety/moving violations, 1 each for Attempted Larceny, DWI, Possession of Marijuana ½ oz to 1 and ½ oz, Disorderly Conduct on Bus, 3 for Shoplifting and 4 for 2<sup>nd</sup> degree trespassing.

Arrests: In October 2023, the Carrboro Police Department made 32 on-view/custodial arrests. The arrests range from Abduction-Children, B&E, Concealed Carry Violation, Conspiracy to Commit Felony, FTA, Financial Card Theft, DWI, to Kidnapping, Misdemeanor Larceny, Obtain CS by Forgery (F), Possession of 5+ Counterfeit Instruments, PWIMSD Marijuana (F), Serious Injury by Vehicle Aggravated Assault, Simple Assault, Trespassing 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> degree.

Incident Reports: There were 304 incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of October 2023, as compared to 204 in the same month from last year (2022).


Crashes: There were traffic 35 crashes in the month of October, no fatalities recorded.
