Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In November 2023, The Carrboro Police Department recorded 1,432 calls for service as compared to 1,310 in the same month the previous year (2022).

Traffic Stops: In November 2023, Carrboro Police performed 92 traffic stops. As a result of those stops 37 citations were issued, 31 verbal warnings given, 19 written warnings issued, 3 on-view arrests were made and 2 instances where no action was taken.

Citations: In November 2023, Carrboro Police issued 49 citations. 17 were for speeding, 15 were regulatory violations, 9 for safety/moving violations, 3 for 2nd degree trespassing, 1 each for Concealed Carry Weapon Violation, Injury to Real Property, Possess Open Container/Consume Alcohol in Passenger Area, and Shoplifting.

Arrests: In November 2023, the Carrboro Police Department made 29 on-view/custodial arrests. The arrests range from Assault on a Female, Break or Enter Vehicle, Breaking or Entering inflicting Terror or Injury, Communicating Threats, Disorderly Conduct, DWLR- Impaired Revocation, FTA in Court/OFA/Per Release Order, Identity Theft, DWI, Intoxicated and Disruptive, Probation Violation, PWIMSD Marijuana, Robbery with Dangerous Weapon, Simple Assault, Statutory Sex offense with child <= 15, 2nd degree Trespass, F Use of Device to Photograph/Peep under Clothing, Violation of DV Protective Order.

Incident Reports: There were 256 incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of November 2023, as compared to 224 in the same month from last year (2022).


Crashes: There were 40 traffic crashes in the month of November, no fatalities recorded.
