Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In February 2024, The Carrboro Police Department recorded 1,369 calls for service as compared to 1,178 in the same month the previous year (2023).

Traffic Stops: In February 2024, Carrboro Police performed 90 traffic stops. As a result of those stops 31 citations were issued, 36 verbal warnings given, 16 written warnings issued, 5 on-view arrests were made and 2 instances where no action was taken.

Citations: In February 2024, Carrboro Police issued 43 citations. 16 were for speeding, 14 were regulatory violations, 6 for safety/moving violations, 1 each for Concealed Weapon Violation, Sell/Give Malt Bev/Wine to <21, Simple Possession of SCH VI CS, and 4 for 2nd Degree Trespassing.

Arrests: In February 2024, the Carrboro Police Department made 16 on-view/custodial arrests. The arrests range from Assault Inflict Serious Injury, Assault on a Female, Crime of Domestic Violence, DWI, DWLR-Impaired Rev, FTA, Misdemeanor Larceny, PWISD SCH VI CS, Sex Offn Viol No Contact Order, and 2nd degree Trespassing.

Incident Reports: There were 241 incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of February 2024, as compared to 214 in the same month from last year (2023).


Crashes: There were 30 traffic crashes in the month of February, no fatalities recorded.
