Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In October 2024, The Carrboro Police Department recorded calls for 1,786 calls for service as compared to 1,717 in the same month the previous year (2023).

Traffic Stops: In October 2024, Carrboro Police performed 196 traffic stops. As a result of those stops 90 citations were issued, 45 verbal warnings given, 47 written warnings issued, 7 on-view arrests were made and 7 instances where no action was taken.

Citations: In October 2024, Carrboro Police issued 102 citations. 57 were for speeding, 33 were regulatory violations, 7 for safety/moving violations, 2 for Possession of Open Container Alcohol in Passenger Area, and 1 each for Injury to Real Property, Possess Paraphernalia, Shoplifting.

Arrests: In October 2024, the Carrboro Police Department made 21 on-view/custodial arrests. The arrests range from Assault on a Female, Breaking and Entering, Carry Concealed Weapon Violation, Crime of Domestic Violence, FTA, Felony Possession of Cocaine, DWI, Hit and Run Leave Scene/Property Damage, Indecent Exposure, Felony Possession Marijuana, Possess Stolen Goods, Probation Violation, Sell/Deliver Schedule II CS, Sexual Battery and Unauthorized Use of MV.

Incident Reports: There were 250 incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of October 2024, as compared to 305 in the same month from last year (2023).


Crashes: There were 42 traffic crashes in the month of October, no fatalities recorded.
