Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In January 2025, The Carrboro Police Department recorded 1,253 calls for service as compared to 1,387 in the same month the previous year (2024).

Traffic Stops: In January 2025, Carrboro Police performed 67 traffic stops. As a result of those stops 24 citations were issued, 30 verbal warnings given, 12 written warnings issued, and 1 on-view arrest was made.

Citations: In January 2025, Carrboro Police issued 30 citations. 11 were for speeding, 13 were regulatory violations, 4 for safety/moving violations, and 2 for 2nd Degree Trespassing.

Arrests: In January 2025, the Carrboro Police Department made 22 on-view/custodial arrests. The arrests range from Assault by Strangulation, Crime of Domestic Violence, FTA, Felony Possession of Cocaine, Habitual Larceny, DWI, Intoxicated and Disruptive, Misdemeanor Larceny, 2nd Degree Trespassing and Sexual Battery.

Incident Reports: There were 211 incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of January 2025, as compared to 214 in the same month from last year (2024).

Crashes: There were 38 traffic crashes in the month of January, no fatalities recorded.
