NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK

“People, Purpose, Presence”

WHEREAS, this year marks the 65th annual observance of National Public Works Week, and the theme of this year’s observance, “People, Purpose, Presence, highlights three cornerstone ideals that motivate public works professionals to serve in their communities every day”; and

WHEREAS, public works professionals focus on infrastructure, facilities, and services that are of vital importance to sustainable and resilient communities and to the public health and well-being of the people of Carrboro; and,

WHEREAS, Carrboro Public Works makes important contributions to the community by providing reliable solid waste collection; street, greenway, and right-of-way maintenance; snow removal; stormwater facility maintenance; mowing and landscaping of Town properties and rights-of-way; tree trimming and removal; ball field preparation and maintenance; facility maintenance; vehicle and equipment maintenance; cemetery maintenance and cemetery plot sales; and more; and

WHEREAS, these infrastructure, facilities, and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals, who are a team of employees at all levels of government, who are responsible for rebuilding, improving, and protecting our nation’s transportation and solid waste systems, public buildings, and other facilities and services for our citizens; and,
