Lunch for children ages 12 and under: All McDonalds in Orange County are providing lunch for kids from Monday to Friday, 11-2pm. Child must be present with a parent or guardian.

Lunch for children: SHEETZ has free daily kids meals, while supplies last. The local participating station is 7520 NC 751, Durham, NC 27713

Dinner: Inter-Faith Council (IFC) serves a dinner for pickup, Monday to Friday, 6:15-7pm at 100 W. Rosemary St.

Lunch: IFC serves a pickup lunch daily at 100 W. Rosemary St. Monday to Saturday from 11:15-12:30pm and Sunday 12:15-1:30pm.

Week of groceries: IFC provides any household with a week's worth of groceries once per month. Call (919) 929-6380 & press 0, or visit to make appt.

## Delivery or other food distribution:

**TABLE** is doing home-based delivery of bags of healthy non-perishables and fresh food to families with children in the Chapel Hill Carrboro City School system. To request food visit <a href="https://www.tablenc.org/request-food">www.tablenc.org/request-food</a>.

PORCH is providing grocery gift cards to families in need. Contact PORCH at chceporchcommunities.org.

Meals on Wheels is delivering meals to older adults once a week. Apply at <a href="https://www.chcmow.org/apply-meals">www.chcmow.org/apply-meals</a> or call 919-942-2948.

**Orange County Seniors Supplemental Food box program** distributes a box of non-perishable groceries once a month to qualified Orange County residents who are over 60. To enroll e-mail shmcpherson@orangecountync.gov or call 919-245-4243.

**Food Not Bombs**: Request food or supplies using their <u>online form</u>. They'll contact you within 48 hours and will call or text you upon arrival and let you know where they leave the supplies.

## NC Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS) Food Assistance

The **Food and Nutrition Services Program (FNS)** is a federal program that provides eligible individuals or families a monthly amount of money for food. Money cannot be used to buy tobacco, pet food, paper products, soap products, or alcoholic beverages. There are 3 ways to apply:

- Apply online with ePass at <u>epass.nc.gov/CitizenPortal/applicaion.do</u>
- Apply in-person at the Orange County Department of Social Services
- Fill out a paper application at <a href="https://www.orangecountync.gov/1870/Application-Information">www.orangecountync.gov/1870/Application-Information</a> and mail in.

WIC provides access to food, breastfeeding support, and encouragement for eligible moms-to-be, new moms and families, and young children up to age 5

Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) Program: This program provides a benefit on an EBT card (like a debit card) to NC families who are eligible for free and reduced lunch at school. Families will receive \$250 in benefits per child, provided in two installments, with the possibility of more if schools are closed beyond May 15. Families do not need to apply for P-EBT.

- Eligible families already receiving Food and Nutrition Services (FNS) benefits will receive an additional benefit on their existing EBT card.
- Eligible families not already enrolled in FNS will be mailed a EBT card in the next few weeks. Families who receive a new EBT card will receive a letter from DHHS in the mail explaining how to activate and use their card.
