

Baldwin Park Community Garden Volunteer Agreement Summer 2011

I, _____ am adopting a community garden bed for 2011 and will follow the garden guidelines as outlined below.

1. Respect of Municipal Property

We appreciate the fact that this land has been made available by the Town of Carrboro for use as a community garden, and we will respect our neighbors and community residents by keeping garden beds well maintained and beautiful.

2. Safety

I will be mindful of my own safety and of my fellow gardeners. I will exercise caution when using tools and hoses. I will maintain any trellises, cages, stacks etc and periodically check to make sure they are secure and stable.

3. Organic Principles

I will garden according to organic principles. Hence, I will use no synthetic fertilizers, pesticides or herbicides. This includes products like "Miracle Grow." Furthermore, I will endeavor to use materials and products that come from sustainable sources and to employ basic principles of water conservation. If you don't know if a product is ok, please ask.

4. Water

I will be judicious in my use of water from the cistern and be aware of watering limits that may be in place. I also understand that the water from the cistern is NOT for drinking but is ONLY for watering garden plants. I will bring drinking water with me to the garden, and I will not drink the cistern water nor let my family or my guests drink the water from the cistern.

5. Sale of Grown Goods

I understand that produce grown in this garden is not for commercial use and may not be sold.

6. Responsibility

I AGREE TO HOLD HARMLESS THE TOWN OF CARRBORO AND THE BALDWIN PARK COMMUNITY GARDEN COMMITTEE FOR ANY LIABILITY, DAMAGE, INJURY, LOSS OR CLAIM THAT OCCURS IN CONNECTION WITH THE USE OR CONSTRUCTION OF THE GARDEN OR WHILE PARTICIPATING IN GARDEN RELATED ACTIVITIES.
