

Carrboro Facility Information

Welcome to Carrboro! We hope you review this brochure and visit our facilities soon!

Our facilities are conveniently located throughout the community. From the 55 acre Anderson Community Park, to the Century Center, to the smaller neighborhood parks, Carrboro provides facilities for a variety of leisure experiences. You can play horseshoes, tennis or softball. You could also go fishing, take a walk or have a picnic. You could even host a wedding reception or birthday party.



Most park facilities are open from 7 am until dark (unless noted), except for lighted facilities, which close at 11 pm.

Reservations for The Century Center can be made from 9:00am to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday at the Century Center facility. Any requested hours beyond normal operational hours are pending the availability of staff and reservation requests.
